Graduation and Graduation Rehearsal

8:30 A.M. - 9:15

This rehearsal is for the Speech and A Cappella Choirs. The doors will be closed to all who are not in the choirs.

9:15 A.M.

All seniors report for rehearsal. Caps and gowns will not be worn at the rehearsal. As you enter the County Center you will be given instructions as to finding your seats. On these instructions will be a sketch of the seating plan and your place in this plan will be indicated. This seating plan will also be posted on the bulletin boards outside each division office on Friday, June 23. Be sure you know your row and seat number before entering the auditorium at County Center.

9:30 A.M.

Seniors not present at 9:35 will be marked absent and will be placed at end of the line of march. Because we march in alphabetical order, and in fours, it will not be possible to choose partners for graduation. Try to march in step with music.

Tickets for admission to graduation exercises will be distributed at the close of this rehearsal. Each senior will receive 5 tickets. Admission will be by ticket only. Please do not ask to collect tickets for other seniors. They must get their own.

Fines

All seniors who do not clear their financial obligations with the school, such as library fines, books, etc., by the time of this rehearsal, will be sent back to their division offices at the high school to pay fines and get their tickets. Tickets will not be available until 2:00 P.M.

GRADUATION EVENING

Do not bring valuables with you this evening. Leave them with friends and relatives. There is no special checking service. As the entire class will sing Orange and the Black, it is imperative that all seniors know the words.

7:15 P.M.

All seniors report in basement of County Center to stations assigned at morning rehearsal. Bring caps and gowns and report promptly. Roll call will be taken at this time. If you are absent from roll call you will be placed at end of line. If you are not at morning rehearsal report to last aisle on left in basement.

8:15

Graduation processional begins. Line of march will be led by class officers, G.O. officers and A Cappella Choir. Seniors march in groups of four.

The recessional. Seniors will receive folders for diplomas and march down aisle single file. Take envelope with left hand, shake hands with right. Go to basement and turn in cap and gown without the boxes. Rental included price of tassel. If you do not wish it 50¢ will be refunded after graduation. After returning caps and gowns, diplomas will be issued at rear of the basement.

Correct form in wearing cap and gown

Cap must be worn so that plane of the square top is parallel to the floor, tassel on right front side. Caps should not be tilted.

Girls do not remove their caps during ceremonies. The only exception to this is for orchestra and choir members, who may remove their hats. It is not considered correct to wear flowers. The dress should not be longer than the gown. White or light shoes are desirable.

Boys remove their caps for Pledge of Allegiance and Star Spangled Banner, for Invocation, and when the Orange and the Black is sung. It is desirable that boys wear white shirts, a tie, dark trousers, and black or brown shoes.

If parents or friends send flowers to a graduate they should be directed to have them delivered to the diploma tables in basement of County Center. They will be given to the graduates when diplomas are distributed.
